ALLOWED IN STUDY AREAS

- dry, non-perishable snacks (crackers, chips, nuts, etc.)
- drinks in sealed bottles and spill-proof, sealed travel mugs















- takeout food, meals, and perishables (pizza, salad, sandwiches, fruit, etc.)
- drinks in open, disposable containers (paper coffee cups, fountain drinks, etc.)
- delivery of food to the library

NO FOOD OR DRINK PERMITTED

- near library equipment (computers, scanners, TVs, stereos, etc.)
- in the library book stacks
- Woodson Research Center
- Digital Media Commons
